

Boys are eligible to play and the NNZ Policy is:

Up to the age of 12 any number of boys can take the court. At the age of 12, a team can have a maximum of 3 boys on court at any one time.

Generally boys are placed at opposite ends of the court, eg attack/defence.

We also have the following Policy:

Boys at Yr 7 & 8 are eligible to play in the Dunedin Netball Centre Competition. They are eligible for selection for representative duties, but the Dunedin Netball Centre Board will have to notify other Centres, if playing away, in the event that boys are registered in representative teams. The Dunedin Netball Centre Board may have to seek permission from other Centres for boys to participate.
